1951	January 28 – Fellowship has its first meeting.
	March 14 - Unitarian Fellowship of Columbia
	receives charter from American Unitarian Association

- 1965 Fellowship selects Shepard Boulevard site for future building.
- **1970** Fellowship moves to Shepard Boulevard.
- **1980** October 26 Fellowship installs its first minister, the Rev. Gertrude V. Lindener (later Lindener-Stawski).
- **1986** Gertrude Lindener-Stawski resigns as minister.
- 1987 Interim Period begins with the Rev. George Brooks.
- 1989 Church calls the Rev. William Haney as minister.
- 1992 Kathie Bergmann becomes Church Administrator; Desi Long becomes Music Director.
- 1995 Joy Amuedo becomes Director of Religious Education. Church votes to expand Shepard Boulevard rather than to purchase United Methodist building on Broadway.
- 1998 UUCC completes Shepard Boulevard expansion.
- 2003 Church dedicates Memorial Garden.
- 2004 Lisa Fritsche becomes DRE.
- **2005** UUCC becomes a Welcoming Congregation (to GLBT community).
- **2009** William Haney resigns as minister, effective May 2010.
- 2010 Interim period begins with the Rev. Sue Spencer.
- 2012 (projected) UUCC calls new settled minister!!
